



GUIDELINES FOR HIRING A BOUNCY CASTLE

To know that you are hiring from a professional inflatable company, we follow strict safety advice and have created a guideline sheet for your information.

▶ **Before contacting us, consider:**

- A. If there is a suitable area for the inflatable you wish to hire?
- B. Is it a grassed area?
- C. Are there objects around the area which may impede the castle being inflated such as trees, or objects that may injure the participants?

▶ **When we deliver the inflatable, we will give you some safety instructions regarding the operation and use. If you are unsure of anything then ask us and we can guide you through the process.**

▶ **Make sure that**

- A. There is availability to peg the inflatable to the ground securely if its outside,
- B. If it is indoors make sure that there is something substantial to weight the inflatable down to avoid movement. We will usually provide weights for this purpose.

▶ **Ask us about the maximum number of participants that can be safely accommodated on the inflatable at any one time.**

This will be influenced by the size of the participants/age using the inflatable.
Implement a rota system if you have mixed groups of ages and sizes.

▶ **Discuss with us regarding any additional equipment that may be required to maximise safety on and around the inflatable, such as fencing.**

▶ **Make sure you are fully informed on what to do if it begins to rain heavy or there are strong winds.**

▶ **Have you organised supervision?**

A responsible adult (18 years and over) must supervise the participants on the inflatable at all times.
If you cannot organise this, we can provide this for you at an additional cost.

▶ **Discuss with us about how to protect participants from the electrical equipment, we can show you our safety measures around this.**
